

# Special Partisan Primary

December 19, 2017

A Partisan Primary is a nominating process. Voting in this primary is your opportunity to express, to one party of your choice, which of the party's candidates you recommend for placement on the Special Election Ballot.

## Ballot Selection and Marking Instructions

- Choose your preferred party:**
- ✓ Choose **ONE party ballot** from this packet on which to vote.
  - ✓ Remove your selected party ballot from the packet.
  - ✓ Vote **only** on the party ballot you selected. If you vote on **more than ONE** party ballot, **no votes will count**.
- 
- Vote for a candidate on your selected party ballot:**
- ✓ Vote for one candidate.
  - ✓ To vote for a name on the ballot, make an "X" or other mark in the square next to the name like this
