Please bring your brown bag lunch.

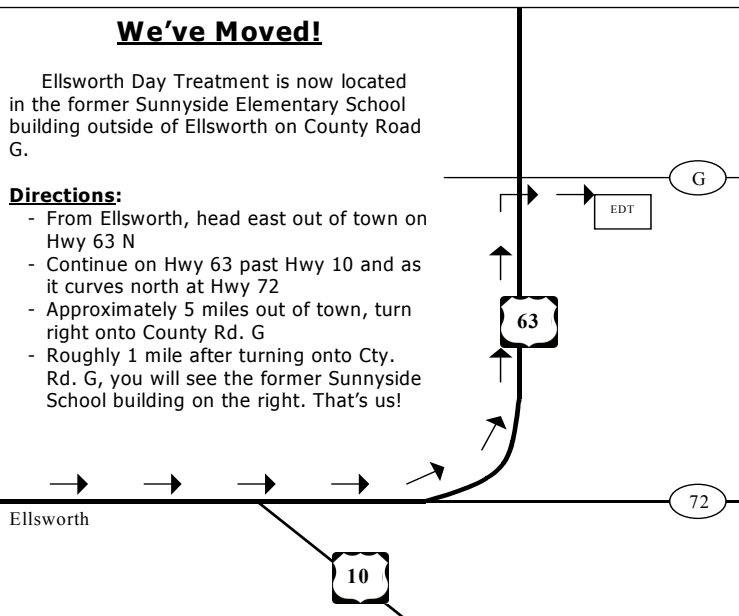
