

SPECIAL WASTE ITEMS

Recycled at the MRF No Charge

MOTOR OIL

Accepted at the Pierce County MRF year round. **Do not mix oil with solvents, gasoline, or anything else!** Please see waste oil guidelines.

(River Falls Residents contact; Bowens Garage, BP Amoco, River Falls Tire, & River Falls Car Wash)

WASTE OIL GUIDELINES

Used motor Oil, transmission & gear oil, hydraulic oil, #2 fuel oil, diesel fuel, kerosene, brake fluid, power steering fluid.

OIL & FUEL FILTERS

NO CHARGE TO HOUSEHOLDS & FARMS

Accepted at the Pierce County MRF.

Drain filters for a minimum of 12 hours.



ANTIFREEZE

Accepted at the Pierce County MRF year round.

NO CHARGE TO HOUSEHOLDS & FARMS

Do not put gas, oil, solvents or any other contaminant into the antifreeze drum. River Falls Car Wash also accepts used antifreeze.

Note: Service stations, auto dealerships & other businesses that service five or more vehicles per month are prohibited from using the oil filter & anti-freeze program.

SCRAP METAL

NO CHARGE

All metal should be free of plastic, wood, glass and rubber. Copper/brass/scrap aluminum are ok (no automobiles). **Size of loads limited** to a pick-up size box full. Call in advance for scheduling deliveries of large size loads.



AUTO BATTERIES

NO CHARGE

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

ACCEPTED AT THE MRF FOR NO CHARGE

Mercury Oxide, Silver Oxide, Lithium, Nickel Cadmium, Nickel Metal Hydride, rechargeable and others.

NOT ACCEPTED AT THE MRF

AAA, AA, C, D, 6V & 9V
