

**ORDINANCE 2013-3**  
County of Pierce  
**TOWN OF ELLSWORTH**

**SCHEDULE OF FEES ORDINANCE**

**SECTION 1. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide efficiency and uniformity in establishing and adjusting the fees charged by the Town of Ellsworth as enumerated throughout the ordinances and policies adopted by the Town of Ellsworth.

**SECTION 2. SCHEDULE OF FEES**

The fees for the various ordinances and policies are established on the Schedule of Fees adopted by this ordinance. Any additions or amendments to the Schedule of Fees can be made by Resolution of the Town Board. Fees shall be paid in cash, personal check, money order, or certified check to the Town of Ellsworth, which shall provide a receipt thereof.

**SECTION 3. CONFLICT OF PROVISION**

The fees set forth in the schedule of fees shall supersede any fee established in other Town Ordinances or policies. If a fee is set forth elsewhere in an ordinance or policy and there is no corresponding fee in the Town Schedule of Fees, the fee listed in the Ordinance or policy shall control until such time the fee is established in the Town Schedule of Fees.

**SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY**

If any provisions of this ordinance are invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication or posting as provided by law.

### Exhibit A: Town of Ellsworth Fee Schedule

Before issuing a town citation, enforcement officials should contact the Pierce County Clerk of Court to determine current court costs and procedures. Deposits shall be made in cash, money order, or certified check to the Pierce County Clerk of Court who shall provide a receipt. The Town of Ellsworth establishes the following schedule of deposits and designates the enforcement official(s) for use with citations issued under this ordinance.
